Behavior Expectations

The Butterfly House & Aquarium is a place of learning, fun, and healing! To make sure that all visitors have a great time at the facility, it is important that teachers, students, and chaperones abide by these behavior expectations:

- Stay with your group. Students and adult chaperones should stay with their group at all times.
- Teachers and chaperones should actively engage in the learning experience of your students. Please avoid cell phone use during your visit.
- Be courteous and respectful of all visitors.
- Talk quietly and walk throughout the facility.
- Listen to Butterfly House & Aquarium staff and volunteer instructions.
- Be respectful of the exhibits and the building. Use books or clipboards to write against, instead of walls or windows of exhibits.
- Do not touch or pick up the butterflies in any way. Wait for the butterfly to land on you.
(Tip: Standing still in the sun is a great way to entice butterflies to land on you!)
- Do not touch, chase, or pick up the quails or turtles in the Butterfly House.
- Do not pick the flowers or leaves in the Butterfly House.
- Help protect the animals. When permitted, touch the animals gently, as directed by staff or volunteers.
- Do not disturb animals by tapping on the windows of exhibits.
- Keep food, drinks, candy, and gum outside the facility. (Water is acceptable throughout the facility.)
